Saw cut asphalt and relocate landscape materials as needed

#### Foundation Piers and Concrete Complete

Install concrete piers-footings for structural steel (posts)
Install all related anchor bolts per specifications and standards (USPS)
Install concrete flat work and curbs per plans, surface drainage
Add two 4" galvanized, concrete embedded bollards at kiosk

Provide and install structural steel per Plan (posts)

# Grading Work and Asphalt

Reposition existing drain swale and landscape boulders as needed Blend existing asphalt at entrance and corners of new concrete Patch Pave new PG&E electrical crossing Overall width and aprons remain same as existing asphalt Add 2" asphalt overlay on entire existing drive isle (2700 +/- square feet) No seal coat, as all aphalt will be new
